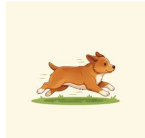


WH Question Answers: Word, Phrase, Sentence

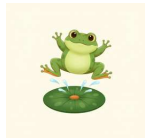


What is the dog doing?

ONE WORD running

PHRASE running very fast

SENTENCE The dog is running across the grass.

What is the frog doing?

ONE WORD jumping

PHRASE jumping up high

SENTENCE The frog is jumping up very high.

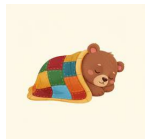

What is the bunny doing?

ONE WORD eating

PHRASE eating a carrot

SENTENCE The bunny is eating a crunchy carrot.

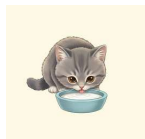

What is the bear cub doing?

ONE WORD sleeping

PHRASE sleeping in bed

SENTENCE The bear cub is sleeping in bed.

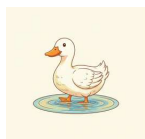

What is the kitten doing?

ONE WORD drinking

PHRASE drinking warm milk

SENTENCE The kitten is drinking milk from a bowl.

What is the duck doing?

ONE WORD swimming

PHRASE swimming in the pond

SENTENCE The duck is swimming across the pond.

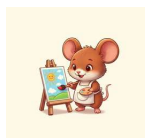

PHRASE reading a book
