

WH Questions Bingo: Four Boards and a Calling List

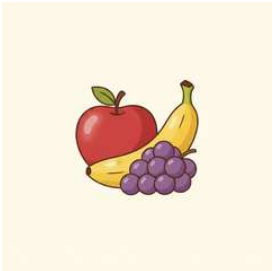
Four different 4x4 boards drawn from the who, what and where questions.

How to play

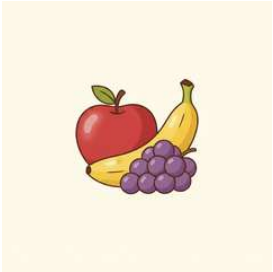
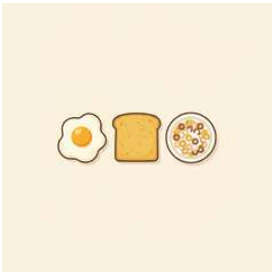
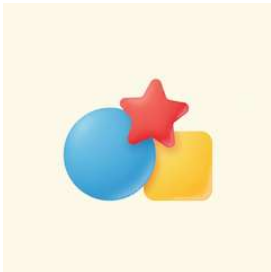
1. Print one board per player, plus the calling list on the last page.
2. Cut the calling list into strips, fold them, and put them in a cup.
3. Draw a strip and say the word. Everyone who has that picture says the word too, then covers it with a coin, a bean or a scrap of paper.
4. Four in a row wins the round. Say all four words again to finish.

Four boards means four players, or one player and four rounds.

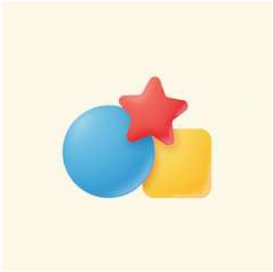
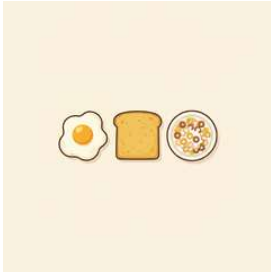
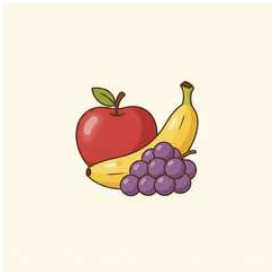
