

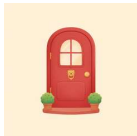
D Sound Ladder: Word, Phrase, Sentence

WORD door

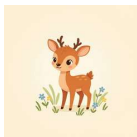
PHRASE the front door

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WORD deer

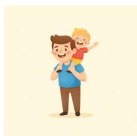
PHRASE a gentle deer

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WORD dance

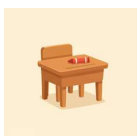
PHRASE a happy dance

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WORD desk

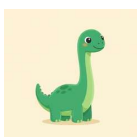
PHRASE a school desk

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WORD dinosaur

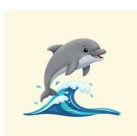
PHRASE a giant dinosaur
