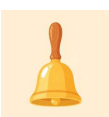
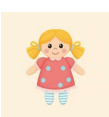
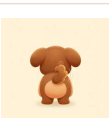
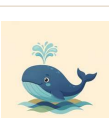
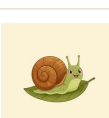
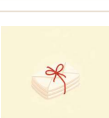
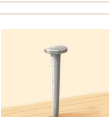
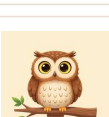


L Sound Sentences: Say the Whole Thing
