

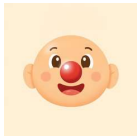
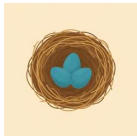
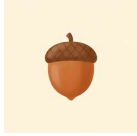
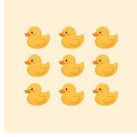
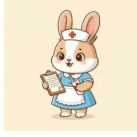
N Sound Ladder: Word, Phrase, Sentence
