

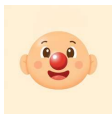
N Sound Sentences: Say the Whole Thing

Read the sentence out loud together, then let your child say it back. Three tries each, and every try counts.

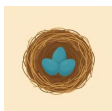

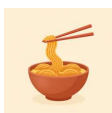
I count nine ducks.

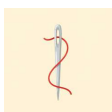
