Eight words, each one climbing from a single word to a whole sentence.

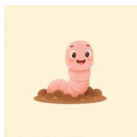
Start at the word. When that feels easy, add the phrase. When the phrase feels easy, try the sentence. It is fine to stay on one rung for a week.

- SENTENCE** The worm wiggles in the dirt. ☐



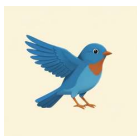
- WORD** wagon ☐

- SENTENCE** I look out the window. ☐



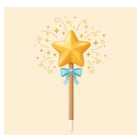
- WORD** web ☐
